**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PUBLIC FACILITIES FUNDING**

WHEREAS, the East St. Louis Township desires to apply for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Facilities funding through St. Clair County, Illinois, to support infrastructure improvements that benefit low-to-moderate income residents; and

WHEREAS, the East St. Louis Township seeks funding for improvements to a public facility known as the Clyde C. Jordan Township Building to enhance accessibility, safety, and community access; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project shall be known as the **“Clyde C. Jordan Public Facility Parking Resurfacing, Accessibility, and Enhancement Project,”** which includes resurfacing and paving of the parking lot and related site improvements to improve mobility, safety, and ADA accessibility; and

WHEREAS, St. Clair County requires an official resolution authorizing submission of the application and execution of required certifications, agreements, and assurances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EAST ST. LOUIS TOWNSHIP BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 – Authorization to Apply

The East St. Louis Township is hereby authorized to submit an application to St. Clair County, Illinois, for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Facilities funds and to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local requirements associated with the program.

Section 2 – Project Identification

The Township Board approves the project titled:
“Clyde C. Jordan Public Facility Parking Resurfacing, Accessibility, and Enhancement Project.”

Section 3 – Execution of Documents

The Township Supervisor, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute all documents, certifications, agreements, assurances, and related materials necessary to submit the application and to carry out the project if funding is awarded.

Section 4 – Compliance and Assurances


The East St. Louis Township agrees to adhere to all Community Development Block Grant regulations, including but not limited to procurement requirements, environmental review procedures, civil rights compliance, and financial management standards.

Section 5 – Additional Information


The Township Supervisor and authorized officials are further empowered to provide any additional information or documentation required by St. Clair County to secure and administer the grant.
