Board of Trustees Meeting

February 25th, 2026

The meeting of the East. St. Louis Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 5:00 P.M. by Supervisor Roy Mosley, Jr.

Opening the meeting with Prayer by Supervisor Mosley.

Roll call to ascertain if a quorum was present.

A quorum was established.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Mosley.

Supervisor Mosley explained that a resolution was discussed to authorize the submission of an application for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Facility funding. The grant writer has already been paid, and this resolution allows them to officially submit the application on behalf of the organization. An update was shared regarding meetings with the State Senator and State

Representative. They have agreed to support a change in the law that would allow the township to qualify for certain state grants. Currently, we do not qualify under existing rules. The proposed law change is expected to move forward in the second or third quarter of 2026. It was noted that the first major compliance steps taken by the organization are now showing results. We have successfully completed its SAM (System for Award Management) federal certification. The next step is obtaining GATA certification; however, eligibility for GATA cannot be finalized until the legislative changes are approved. The township is actively working toward this and is encouraged by the cooperation being received. Once these requirements are fully in place, the organization will be positioned to pursue larger state grants and expand into additional major programs.

Under new business, updates were provided on construction. The bathroom contractor has been selected and will be voted on by City Council. The contractor met with the plumber to review prior repairs and ensure coordination as construction moves forward. Bathroom construction will begin soon, and once work starts, that portion of the facility will temporarily close for repasses. A backup ADA-compliant restroom will be available during this time. Roof work is scheduled to begin at the end of March. Kitchen renovations are also moving forward. Each kitchen will require an individual grease trap, which will involve additional plumbing upgrades. Specifications and scopes of work have been prepared and will be sent out simultaneously. A construction meeting will be scheduled with all contractors to coordinate timelines and properly phase the work. Leadership expressed satisfaction with the collaboration and progress of the construction process.

The chair entertained a motion to adjourn. It was moved by Trustee Lewis and seconded by Trustee Dancy. Motion carried to adjourn the meeting.
